

E-LEARNING COURSE

Confined Spaces Safety Awareness

Confined spaces can be hazardous if not approached with an understanding of how to prepare for entry, how to enter and work safely, and what to do if an incidence occurs.

This course will introduce you to the types of confined spaces and the associated hazards. You will learn about the activities within a confined space, and codes of practice. Different types of hazard controls are presented including engineering, administrative, and protective equipment. Confined space entry procedures including the rescue plan, and evacuation (escape) plan as well as your roles and responsibilities in post-entry inspections and retention of records are explained.

This course is intended for everyone working in confined spaces in any part of the country, in any sector (residential, industrial, commercial, institutional, pipeline, civil).

A final mark of 100% is required in order to receive 1 Gold Seal Credit. Successful completion of this course will enable the student to:



- Understand the types of confined spaces
- Assess and control hazards and recognize potential hazards
- Understand your roles and responsibilities prior to entry, while working, and on leaving a confined space
